

Parent support with Remote Learning at DMSC

During this period when students will be learning from home due to COVID-19, the following guidelines will assist parents to support their child with remote learning:

- **Online learning** will be delivered via Edmodo and some senior classes will use WebEx. Year 7 – 10 will have some brief year level meetings via WebEx.
- **Timetable:**
 - Year 11 and 12 students will follow their normal timetable, and staff will be available to communicate with students at this time.
 - Year 7 - 10 students should follow the timetable below:

English: 9.00-9.50 am

Maths: 10.00-10.50 am

P.E: 11.00-11.30 am

Recess: 11.30-12.00 pm

Other Subjects: 12.00-2.00 pm (with breaks between work as required)

- **Communication between staff and students** will be strictly curriculum focused and in line with Child Safe Standards and DMSC Behaviour Expectations.
- **Communication between parents and teachers** will be made using Edmodo and text messages using XUNO
- **Feedback** to students regarding their work will be provided by staff in a timely manner via Edmodo.
- **Supervision** - Parents/carers will ensure that their child/ren continue to complete the set curriculum tasks by the due date. *Please refer to the Teaching and Learning document that will be posted on the website each week for dates when work is due.*
